In the interest of a prompt and speedy settlement of the above captioned matter, consistent with the public interest, statutory requirements and the responsibilities of the Arizona Peace Officer Standards and Training Board (AZPOST), and pursuant to A.R.S. §41-1822(A)(3), 41-1822(D) and 41-1092.07(F)(5), the undersigned parties enter into this Consent Agreement as a final disposition of this matter.

CONSENT AGREEMENT

- Respondent, without admitting any misconduct or failure to meet minimum qualifications, hereby permanently relinquishes his Arizona peace officer certification.
- AZPOST agrees to make no findings of dishonesty or conclusions of rule violations under A.A.C. R13-4-109(A).
- Respondent waives his right to hearing, rehearing, review, reconsideration, appeal, or judicial review of the action, and further waives the requirements of Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law for the Decision and Order below to be final and effective.
- Respondent and AZPOST agree that this consent to relinquishment of peace officer certification shall permanently bar Respondent from work as a certified peace officer in Arizona, as required by A.A.C. R13-4-105(A)(8).
- Respondent understands that the public records law and open meeting law apply to AZPOST. Nothing in this Agreement shall be interpreted to accord secrecy to

the records of AZPOST above and beyond that already required by law. This Consent Agreement and Order is a public record.

- 6. Respondent understands AZPOST participates in the National Decertification Index (NDI) maintained by the International Association of Directors of Law Enforcement Standards and Training and will be entered into the NDI as a voluntary relinquishment of peace officer certification.
- 7. Respondent understands that he has the right to consult with and be represented by an attorney regarding this Agreement and all Arizona POST proceedings. Respondent avows that he has either done so or waives his right to an attorney.
