- 1. Colt .45 caliber, model M1991A1, Series 80 pistol;
- 2. Smith and Wesson, .357 revolver;
- 3. Mossberg 5.56 rifle;
- 4. New Haven by Mossberg 12 gauge shotgun;
- 5. Omni .22 caliber long rifle;
- 6. WASR-10 7.52 x 39mm rifle;
- 7. Russian M1938 7.62 x 54R rifle;
- 8. Marlin 30/30 caliber, model 336CS;
- 9. Remington .22 caliber, model 511-X long rifle with scope; and
- 10. Draco 7.62 x 39 mm rifle

the firearms were shipped and transported in interstate and foreign commerce.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).
